Description

Our study of 1 & 2 Corinthians will be chronological through the text as we consider historical, grammatical, linguistic, and theological context. By the end of the semester, students should have a working knowledge of the content, meaning, and historical situation of Paul's epistles to Corinth.

Course Objectives and Requirements

To provide the student with a working knowledge of these New Testament books, how they fit together in the whole of Scripture, and how they are relevant for the church today.

Textbooks and Materials

The Bible and Brian's Notes on 1 & 2 Corinthians.

Assignments

- The student is expected to memorize the following verses: 1 Corinthians 1:10-15; 1 Corinthians 1:20-21; 1 Corinthians 3:16-17; 1 Corinthians 4:17; 1 Corinthians 5:9-13; 1 Corinthians 6:19-20; 1 Corinthians 9:24-27; 1 Corinthians 10:12-13; 1 Corinthians 11:23-27; 1 Corinthians 13:4-7; 1 Corinthians 16:1-2; 2 Corinthians 1:3-5; 2 Corinthians 9:6-8. The memory verses *are not cumulative*.
- The student is expected to read the chapters of the text that will be covered each given week and be prepared to discuss them in class.
- There will be 4 tests including the midterm and the final. Each test will consist of 10 true or false, 10 short answer, and 5 medium-length response questions.
