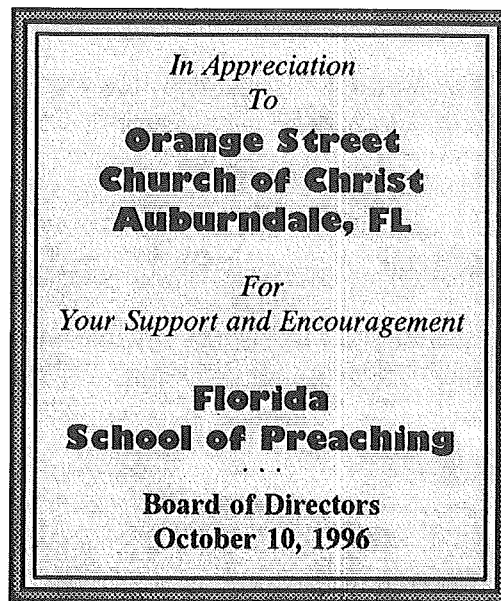
Auburndale Honored At Annual Banquet

He did so without charging the school for his services. That which could have cost from \$100.00 to \$150.00 per hour to design, he did without charge to the school. His generosity does not end there. He also has a server on which the Web Site is placed. This 20mb of space, he is providing free to the school. We are truly thankful to JEAN-LOUIS GUAY for what he has done and is doing for the school.

When the page is accessed you will see the heading that you see in this publication. Below this is a spinning world globe in the center of the page. Under the world image is a graphic of an elevated city, to the left of the city is a flashing light on a lighthouse in the sea. Beneath these two images is a moving strip with Matthew 5:14, "Ye are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hid." Beneath this strip is another moving strip that welcomes you to the Florida School of Preaching Web Page.

When you choose to view the school catalogue you will be able to access various sections of the catalogue. Any of these may be printed on a printer that is connected to the computer you are using to access the Web Site. The following may be downloaded as well as viewed:

At the present time those accessing the Web Site from anywhere in the world can, if they have a printer connected to the computer they are using to view the site, download a registration form or order Florida School of Preaching Lectureship Books as well as some of the Class Notes used in classes.

Each teaching article from the pages of the Harvesters may be placed in a section entitled MONTHLY PUBLICATION, and may be downloaded as described earlier.

Plans in the future are to have video sermons and a video presentation of the class facilities. The developer of our site wants to make the information from the catalogue above in multiple languages. While being read in other languages the prospective student will understand that he must be able to function in English in order to attend.

There is the possibility of having a active chat session on the Web Site. A topic could be proposed and those interested could access the

page at a given hour and have give and take conversation with someone from school. Sermon outlines could be attached to the site and be downloaded by the readers. Perhaps a list of churches supporting the school could be provided with the site. This would enable those reading about the school to know some of those supporting our work.

In a practical way, materials could be sent by E-Mail anywhere in the world. The only need would be to have a computer that can access the Web Site.

Much time and talent is being devoted to making the Web Page a practical tool for reaching out to the world with information about the school. I know of no better way to make the school known throughout the world than with this world wide access. The total monthly cost (\$17.95) is far less than our ad in *The Gospel Advocate* (\$87.00) or *The Firm Foundation* (\$48.00).

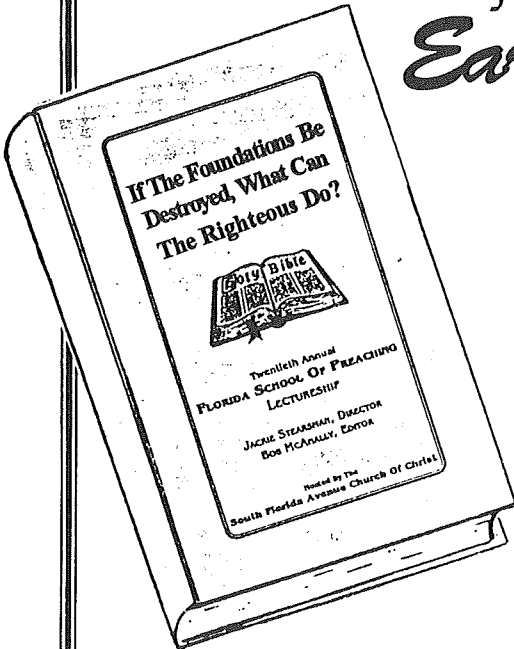
