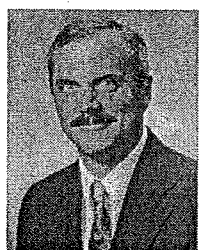

Worshiping God in spirit and in truth is one of the most meaningful and rewarding activities in which a Christian can engage. It is meaningful because it implies that the worshiper is in good standing with God, able to approach Him because of the redemptive work of Christ. It is rewarding because the worshiper, though humbled in God's presence, is strengthened and motivated to vigorously serve the Lord, so much so that when the Christian forsakes such opportunities, he or she is seriously weakened in faith (Heb. 10:19-25).

For worship to be meaningful and rewarding, it must be done according to God's word, in both action and attitude (Jn. 4:24). God does not need mankind to worship him. Rather, mankind needs a worshipful relationship with God. God has revealed a specific pattern as to how he desires to be worshiped. However, the details of this pattern are not revealed in a single verse, but they must be ascertained through diligent study of the whole counsel of God.

This lectureship book will be a valuable tool in ascertaining God's way of worship. The majority of the book will contain the oral presentations of the lectures as listed on the schedule. 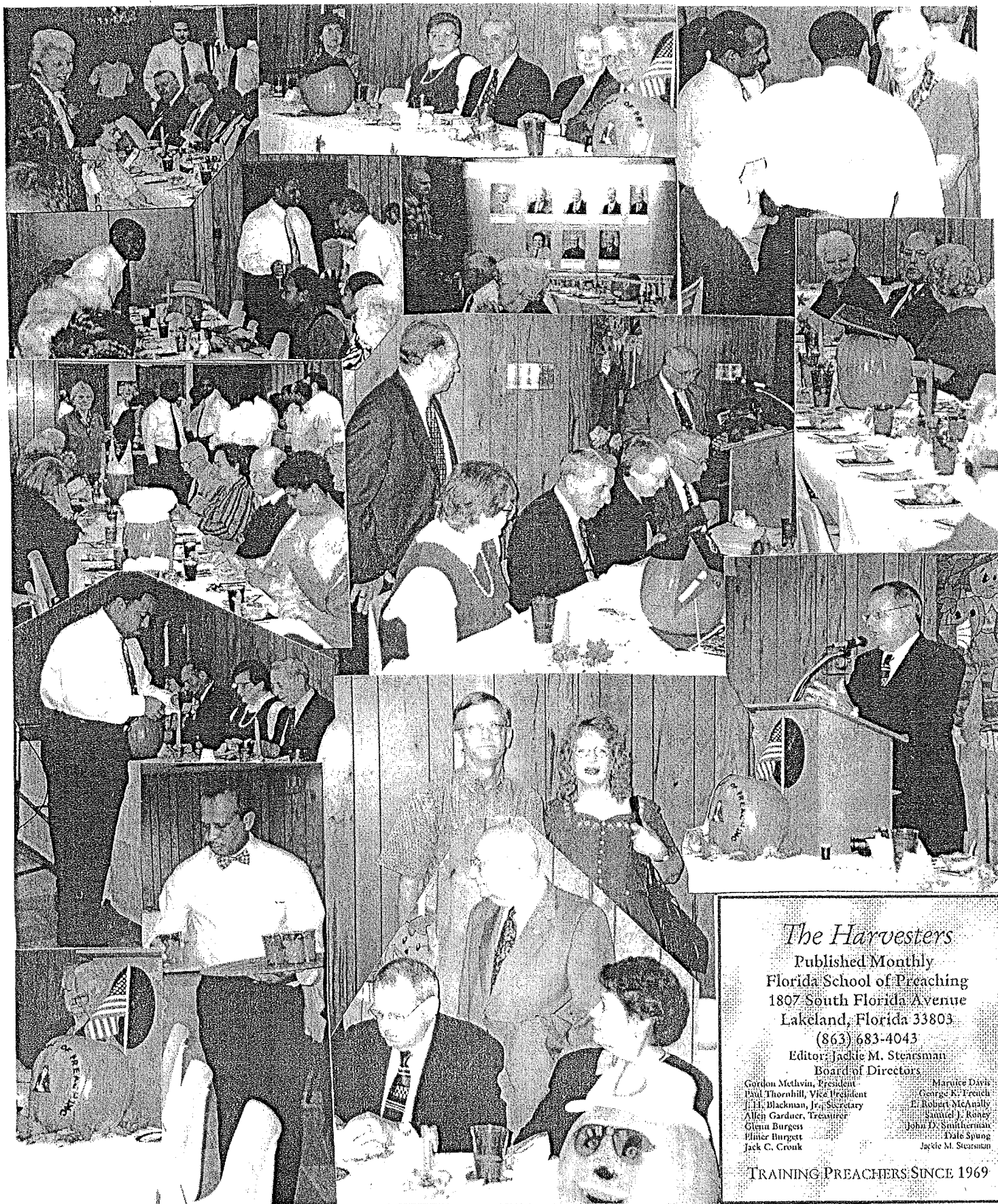

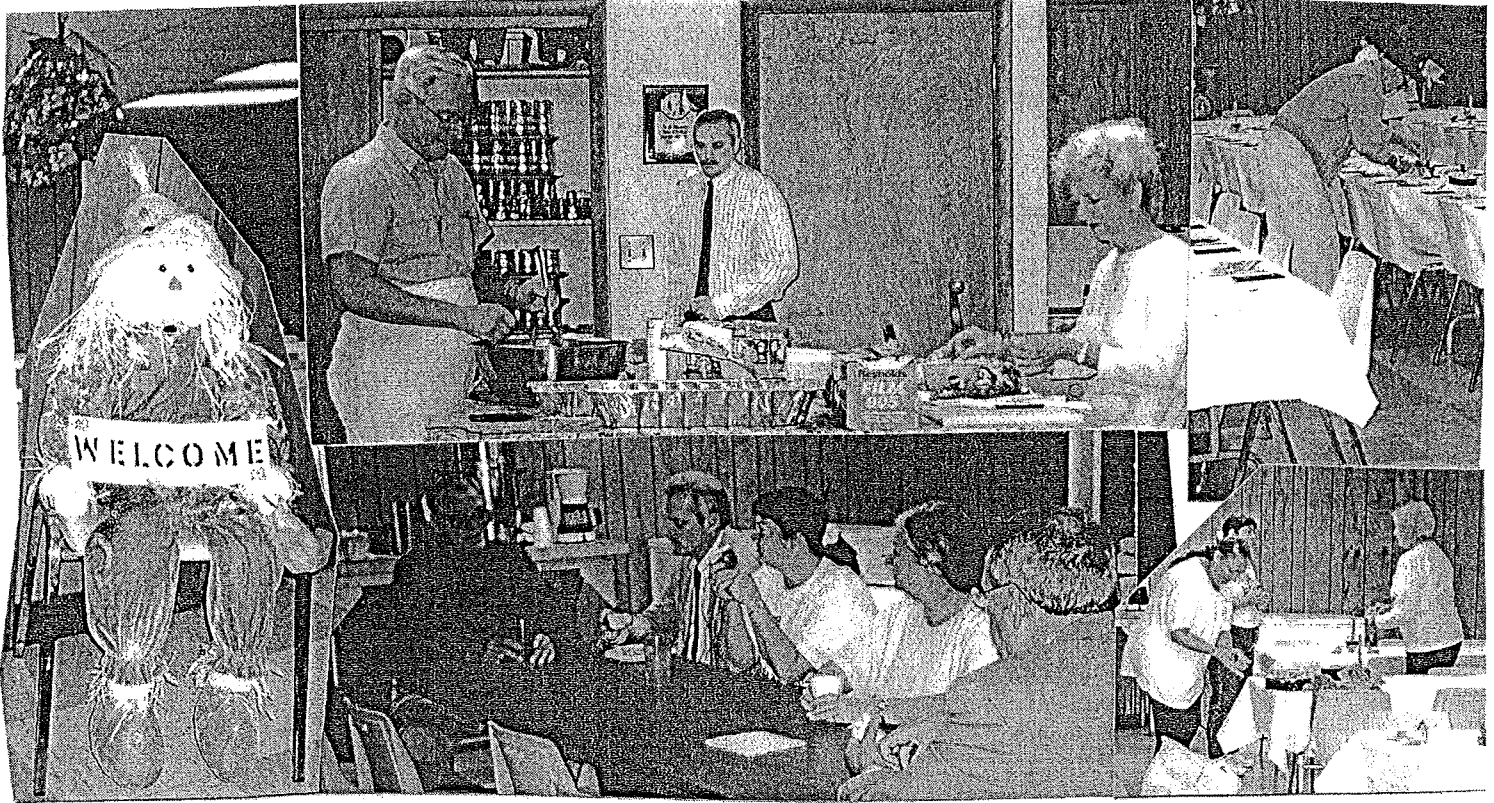
