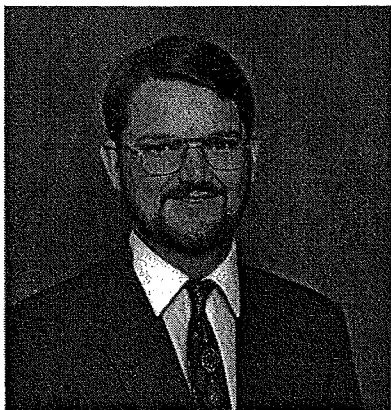

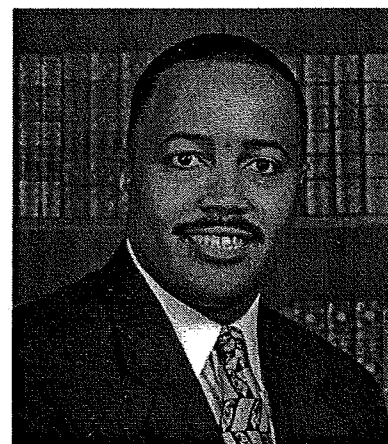
In addition to his preaching preparation, he graduated in August
