"Do You Understand Truth?" A Preview of the 2014 Lectureship Book

Today's popular culture would have us to believe that there is no such thing as objective truth. Whether in politics, the news media, public education, and especially religion, a person having the audacity to even claim that there is such a thing as truth is met with ridicule and disgust! The school's 39th annual lectureship will better prepare God's people to meet the challenges we face in understanding truth. As can be seen from the schedule inside, the lectureship will deal with many, practical aspects of truth. The excerpts below especially concern the philosophical challenges to truth and their implications to our society. First, Rick Kenyon states,

Truth contains properties that bear relevance to philosophical challenges. First, truth is one sided—it is consistent with itself...Second, truth cannot be created nor destroyed, only recognized. It is "metaphysical matter" which is intricately connected with God and his nature... Third, truth is timeless. It is nonsensical to ask, "When did truth begin?" It has always been in existence because God has always

been in existence; truth is a part of God's nature (Deut. 32:4; Ps. 31:5)...Fourth, truth is immutable—it does not change. A particular belief may be accepted as truth when it is actually false. The realization of a currently held false belief does not change the truth, only what one perceives as truth (e.g., belief that the earth was flat). Perceived truth is not the same as actual truth.

Daniel Stearsman brings many good points about postmodernism, among which concerns an attitude common to many truth deniers.

One approach that seems pervasive in postmodernism is presenting dilemmas that really are not dilemmas at all. For example, in the area of knowledge, one is either ignorant and humble, or arrogant and certain...What about the possibility, though, of being ignorant and arrogant or certain and humble? Are these not viable options? The Bible teaches that people can be both humble and certain (cf. Lk. 1:4; Heb. 6:19; Phil. 2:3). To have humility does not necessarily exclude knowing with certainty.

Mark McWhorter's chapter comes in a section dealing with the role of truth (or lack thereof) in societal practices. His chapter, "Truth and 'Same Sex Marriage," is partially written in light of the Supreme Court decision on June 26, 2013.

If someone thinks the slippery slope [from allowing homosexuals to marry] to legalized pedophilia presented is bogus, consider the 2011 symposium held in Baltimore... pedophilia was redefined as "minor attracted persons," and

the symposium sought to raise concerns about how the DSM1 [Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders published by the American Psychiatric Association] considers it a mental disorder. One of the lectures was titled "Decriminalizing Mental Disorder Concepts—Pedophilia as an Example."

Atheism is a prime example of society giving "credibility" where there is none according to truth. Eric Lyons concludes his article.

When atheism is stripped of pompous proclamations and arrogant allegations, its naked soul is seen for what it really is: weak, illogical, unscientific, and worthless. ... While trying to convince others it is galloping confidently atop a stallion called Common Sense, atheism stumbles on the back of a donkey called Foolishness. Is there any wonder why David said, "The fool has said in his heart, 'There is no God'" (Ps. 14:1)?.


