

Florida School of Preaching Information & Guidelines for Online Students

Books

Online students are responsible for securing copies of the books required for classes. Some books and study notes will be available through FSOP. Sources will be provided for books not available at FSOP. Books are required if taking class for credit, optional if just auditing.

Class Recordings

All classes will be recorded, and these recordings will be available no later than the day after the class is held. Students will receive an email with instructions to access these recordings. Access to these recordings should not be shared. All those interested in a class must register with FSOP and then will be given access to their class recordings.

Attendance

1. Students taking classes for credit must attend and participate live during **all** class periods with their **video on**, as if they were on campus. Exceptions will only be made for excused absences or as otherwise approved by the director.
2. For credit students who miss class are expected to watch the recording of each class missed and submit notes to the instructor or other proof that they watched the class.
3. All assignments, tests, quizzes, etc. must be turned in according to the due dates given by the instructor.
4. FSOP rules of conduct and dress code apply to online students.
5. Students who satisfactorily complete course requirements totaling 120 semester credit hours through FSOP's online program will receive a certificate of completion for online studies. This is not equivalent to the traditional graduation and diploma awarded to in-person students.
